YOUTH-LED EVALUATION FRAMEWORK

The below steps provide a framework for involving young people in the evaluation process through workshops, surveys, and interviews. You can use this to gather young people's thoughts about the initiative itself, or their own involvement.

1. PLANNING

Involve young from the start by co-designing evaluation questions that matter to them.

2. DATA COLLECTION

Young people can lead focus groups, conduct peer interviews, or run surveys with their peers.

3. FEEDBACK SESSIONS

Schedule regular sessions where young people can provide feedback on the project's direction and outcomes.

4. UNDERSTANDING THE INFORMATION

Allow young people to help analyse the information you have collected to make sense of the outcomes and impact. What you think young people are saying may not actually be what they're saying.

5. SHARING THE RESULTS

Present the findings from your evaluation to the young people and support them to co-present or suggest changes based on the results.
